The other day I was going through the check-out line at the grocery store and I saw a popular magazine with Moses pictured on the front. It reminded me that during this time of year leading up to Easter, there is much more interest in the Bible and spiritual things. (This is true even when people have trouble distinguishing between the Old Testament which tells us about Moses and the New Testament which tells us about Jesus.)

What does that mean for you and me? It means that if we will be open and sensitive to the leading of the Holy Spirit, we will find many opportunities to have conversations about spiritual things. During this season leading up to Easter, watch for open doors to talk to people about Jesus. Make Paul's prayer your own prayer. He wrote, "praying at the same time for us as well, that God will open up to us a door for the word. . ." (Col. 4:3a, NASB).
